EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR THE DESIGN AND SUPPLY OF CORPORATE UNIFORM

Uganda Revenue Authority (URA) is inviting Expressions of Interest (EOI) from suitably qualified providers **for the supply of URA Corporate Uniform.**

Interested providers must provide information in their EOI indicating that they are qualified to perform the assignment by attaching documentary evidence of past similar accomplishments carried out with variable references. The eligibility requirements include the following:

- Original Tax Clearance Certificate for the year of income 2008/2009 for local bidders.
- Audited Accounts for the last 3 years
- Names of Directors, staff and their qualifications.
- Details of similar work undertaken including client list, especially in Africa for the last five years.
- Valid copy of your Trading License for local bidders and other relevant licenses, if any.
